

## **PANERA BREAD HIGH SCHOOL SOCCER CLASSIC RULES**

1. OHIO HIGH SCHOOL RULES APPLY, UNLESS LISTED DIFFERENTLY IN TOURNAMENT RULES.
2. TEAM WAIVER FORM MUST BE HANDED IN TO TOURNAMENT OFFICIALS 1 HOUR PRIOR TO FIRST GAME.
3. A game is 40 minutes without a half time.
4. CLOCK IS CONTINUOUS EXCEPT FOR FINALS PAIRING GAMES WHEREBY CLOCK STOPPAGE WILL FOLLOW OHIO HIGH SCHOOL RULES.
5. Final pairing are determined by points earned. 3 points for a win, 1 point for a tie and 0 points for a loss. The 2 teams with the most points after round robin play will play for the championship. Tie breakers are in this order: 1) head to head (skip if more than 2 teams are tied), 2) net goals scored - goals scored less goals allowed - max. 4 per game, 3) least goals against, 4) Most goals scored - max. 4 per game, 5) Penalty kicks. 5 per team, alternating. If tied after 5 each, 1 per team will be selected until the tie is broken. The penalty shooters can be anyone who is dressed to play and rostered.
6. TIES DURING NON-FINAL PAIRING GAMES WILL RESULT IN A TIE - NO OVERTIME OR SHOOTOUT.
7. TIES DURING FINAL PAIRING GAMES are settled by 1 - 5 minute SUDDEN DEATH overtime period. If a tie still exists after 5 minutes, penalty kicks will take place following Ohio High School rules.
8. A team that fails to field 8 players 5 minutes after the scheduled kick off, will forfeit. The score will be 4-0. Any use of illegal players will result in a forfeiture of all games.
9. REFEREE'S DECISIONS ARE FINAL - NO PROTESTS - NO APPEALS.
10. INCLEMENT WEATHER: The tournament committee and/or director in cooperation with the referees have the right to stop games due to weather. DUE TO CIRCUMSTANCES OR CONDITIONS BEYOND CONTROL, THE TOURNAMENT COMMITTEE WILL NOT BE RESPONSIBLE FOR ANY REFUNDS.
11. EJECTIONS: Any player, coach, assistant coach or manager receiving a red card will not be permitted to participate in the remainder of the game and the following game. Suspension from additional games will be contingent upon a review of the violation after receipt of the referee report. A 2nd red card results in suspension from the remainder of the tournament.
12. MEDICAL RELEASE FORMS - Each team must have a medical release form for each player rostered at registration.
13. HOME TEAM - The home team is the FIRST team listed. In the case of similar color uniforms, the home team will change to their alternate jersey.
14. DISPUTES - Any disagreement which cannot be resolved by the listed rules will be settled by the Tournament Committee.
15. Home team provides game ball.
16. AWARDS: 1<sup>st</sup> place awarded a school championship plaque and each team member of 1<sup>st</sup> & 2<sup>nd</sup> place teams awarded medals. Gold for 1<sup>st</sup> place and silver for 2<sup>nd</sup> place. Good Luck to all the teams!
